NOTICE OF RACE

JELÖLÉSEK:

[DP] The penalty for a breach of this rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

[NP] A rule that shall not be grounds for protests by a boat. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

1. SZABÁLYOK

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS). RRS Appendix B will apply. Other document under RRS Definition: Rule (g) will be the Notice of Race of the Windsurf Hungarian Championship.
- 1.2. If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2. ADVERTISING

2.1. Boards may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies. **[DP]**

3. ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY, FEES

- 3.1. The regatta is open to all boards of the following classes:
 - (a) Formula,
 - (b) Windsurf Foil,
 - (c) RS:X 8.5 (Women, Youth),
 - (d) RS:X (Men).
 - (e) Raceboard (Overall, Master, Grand Master, Veteran, Women),
 - (f) Bic Techno 293 (Plus, U17, U15, Boys, Girls), and
 - (g) Light Wind Freestyle.
- 3.2. Competitors of different genders in Raceboard and Bic Techno 293 classes will be scored separately provided that at least 5 entries are received in both genders. Other categories in brackets (age groups and genders) will be scored separately, regardless of the number of entries.
- 3.3. The required entry fee is 5.000 HUF for each competitors in all classes. Hungarian competitors may choose to pay an annual entry fee: 10.000 HUF per class. Early bird entries may be sent by email to windsurf@hwa.hu, on-site registration is necessary.
- 3.4. The following documents shall be presented at registration:
 - (a) liability insurance,
 - (b) proof of identity.
 - (c) sports medical license (only competitors with Hungarian nationality).

5. EQUIPMENT AND INSPECTION

- 5.1. The organizing authority will not supply and equipment for competitors.
- 5.2. A board shall comply with RRS 78.1 at 10:00 on 8 June 2019.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1. Copies of the sailing instructions will be available at the on-site race office during registration.

7. VENUE

7.1. The regatta center will be the Windsurf Center of Balatonaliga, located in Club Aliga (8171 Balatonvilágos, Aligai út 1.).

8. COURSES

8.1. Course races will be sailed on windward-leeward or trapezoid courses.

9. SCORING

- 9.1. One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 9.2. When scoring categories,
 - (a) finishing places will be determined by the order in which boards finish a race in their categories. This changes RRS A3.
 - (b) the number of boards entered will be the number of boards entered in the category. This changes RRS A4.2.
- 9.3. The regatta of the Light Wind Freestly class will be scored by judges.

10. BERTHING

10.1. Boards shall be kept in their assigned places while they are ashore. [DP]









11. RADIO COMMUNICATION

11.1. Except in an emergency or when using equipment provided by the organizing authority, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. [DP]

12. DÍJAK

- 12.1. Prizes will be given as follows:
 - (a) The top 3 boards of each class or their separately scored categories will be awarded.
 - (b) Prize money is offered by FA for the overall top 3 boards in the RS:X 8.5, the RS:X, the Windsurf Foil, the Raceboard and the Light Wind Freestyle classes: 1st place: 50.000 HUF, 2nd place 30.000 HUF, 3rd place 20.000 HUF.
 - (c) Product prizes are offered by Rip Curl for the overall top 3 boards in the Formula and the Techno classes.
 - (d) A complete Gun freestyle sail set (boom, sail and mast) is offered by the Vento Windsurf Shop for the overall winner of the Light Wind Freestyle class after the 5 rounds of the championship. The winner of the prize shall have valid results in at least three of the five rounds.

13. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

13.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

14. INSURANCE

14.1. Each participating board shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 500.000 EUR per incident or the equivalent.

15. MEDIA RIGHTS

15.1. Competitors grant to the organizing authority, the Hungarian Windsurfing Association and their sponsors the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the athlete during the period of the competition without compensation.
